

How To Download SBI PO Hall Ticket 2021?

The SBI PO Admit card 2021 will be released online mode.

For this, candidates must visit the official website to download the admit card.

Check the stepwise process to download the SBI PO hall ticket 2021 as mentioned below:

- **1st Step:** Visit the official website – sbi.co.in.
- **2nd Step:** Click on ‘Careers’ present on the top-right corner of the page
- **3rd Step:** Click on the ‘Latest Announcement’ link and look for the option ‘Recruitment of Probationary Officers’
- **4th Step:** Click on the link ‘Main Examination Call Letter’.
- **5th Step:** A login page will appear. Then, enter your ‘Registration Number’ or ‘Roll Number’ and ‘Password’ or ‘Date of Birth’, and ‘Captcha Code’ and then click on the ‘Login’ button.
- **6th Step:** The admit card will be displayed. Go through the details and download the admit card. Take a printout for future reference.

Details Given on SBI PO 2021 Admit Card

Candidates must go through the details mentioned on the SBI PO admit card 2021 and ensure that all the details are correct. In case of any discrepancy, report to the authorities for rectification to avoid any last-minute complication. The details mentioned on the SBI PO 2020 hall ticket are as follow:

1. Name of the candidate
2. Roll No./ Registration No.
3. Date of Birth
4. Category
5. Gender
6. Candidate’s Photograph
7. Specified space for thumb impression and signature
8. Date & Time of the exam
9. Name & Address of the exam centre
10. Specified space for invigilator’s signature

Documents to be Carried with SBI PO Admit Card 2021

Along with admit card, candidates should carry the hard copy of the SBI PO Admit Card 2021 to the exam hall. Candidates failing to carry the admit card will not be

allowed to write the exam. Besides this, candidates should carry a valid photo ID proof for verification. Check the following important documents required during the examination.

1. Hardcopy of the SBI PO Admit Card
 2. Valid Photo ID Card
 3. A recent passport size photo affixed on your SBI PO hall ticket
 4. Caste/ PwD Certificate for Reservation Claim, if required
 5. Aadhaar Card
 6. PAN Card
 7. Driving License
 8. Voter's ID
 9. Passport
- Bank's Passbook (with duly attested photograph)
Valid Photo Identity Card Issued by School/ College

SBI PO Admit Card 2021: Barred Items in the Exam Hall

Check the list of barred items, i.e., things not permitted at the exam centre are mentioned below. Candidates should make sure that these items are not carried on the day of the exam

1. Food items, opened or packed.
2. Pencil boxes, geometry box, writing pads, logbooks, etc.
3. Any printed material apart from the SBI PO call letter and the Photo ID card.
4. Digital wristwatch and analogue watches.
5. Electronic devices, including mobile phones, calculators, scanning devices, cameras, Bluetooth devices, etc.

SBI PO Admit Card 2021: General Guidelines

Candidates appearing for the exam should note the important guidelines regarding SBI PO Call Letter 2021 as mentioned below:

1. Candidates should report to the exam center at least 15 minutes before the time mentioned on the admit card.
2. In order to be able to reach the venue on the reporting time, the candidates are advised to check out the venue a day before the exam to familiarize themselves with the route.
3. Candidates must carry a hand sanitizer of 50 ml.
4. They must have the Arogya Setu App downloaded on their phone.
5. It is compulsory to carry the hard copy of the admit card along with a valid photo ID proof (in original).
6. After downloading the admit card, go through all the details mentioned on it. In case of any discrepancy, report to the official authority at the earliest.
7. Name, photo, date of birth, and other essential details mentioned on the admit card should match with the photo ID proof.
8. The photo and other details on the e-admit card printout and the ID proof must be clear and legible.
9. Candidates must report to the exam centre as per the reporting time. Late candidates will not be allowed to take the exam.

Biometric verification of the candidate can be captured at the exam centres. Thus, candidates are advised not to apply anything like ink, chemical, etc. on their hands. Read the instructions mentioned on the admit card and abide by the same.
